#### **BEWARE OF THIS SCAM**

Attention business owners in the neighborhood:

At the beginning of each year, many businesses are required to file an annual report with the Colorado Secretary of State Office. There is a scam being sent via postcards to Colorado's businesses. These solicitations are similar to the official one that the state sends to the businesses. The postcards are sent by a California company. It states that if you pay \$150, this company will file the corporate annual meeting minutes with the state on your behalf.

If you receive this postcard, do not pay the fee. Colorado does not require corporations to file annual shareholder meeting minutes. Contact the Colorado Secretary of State Office and send them the postcard. For more information, you can log in to Colorado Secretary of State's website.

### 2009 WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MEMBERSHIP FEES DUE

Thank you to everyone that has paid their 2009 Waste Management and membership fee. If you haven't paid yet, remember your home owners's membership dues and Waste Management pickup payment need to be paid before the 15<sup>th</sup> of February, 2009, if you want to have the discount on trash hauling. The cost for trash pickup is \$130.80 and the membership fee is \$25 for a total of \$155.80.

If you are not interested in participating in the Waste Management deal, your membership dues of \$25 still are due by February 15<sup>th</sup>. #### Beef Bar B Que

3-4 lbs beef (chuck)

1/4 cup chopped onion

1 teaspoon salt

1/4 cup cold water

Use your favorite method to cook for 4 hours.

(Can place all ingredients in a dutch oven pan

in a 300 degree oven.)

Shred the meat with forks.

Add to meat and simmer 1 1/2 hours:

8 oz. tomato sauce

8 oz. tomato paste

2 Tablespoon sugar

1/4 cup vinegar

1/4 cup lemon juice

1/2 cup chopped onion

1 tablespoon salt

2 tablespoons Worchestershire sauce

1 teaspoon cinnamon

1 teaspoon dried mustard

4 drops tabasco

Serve shredded beef on buns.

This freezes well.
