AARP DRIVER SAFETY PROGRAM

A great way to possibly save money – AARP provides a driving safety program.

- It's an 8-hour classroom refresher course for drivers age 50 or older.

- Minimal fee, and no tests!

- Auto insurance discounts in most states – call your insurance company.

DRIVING TIPS

Studies show that chatting on a phone while driving increases your crash risk by 400%. Such driver distractions are a factor in 4.9 million vehicle accidents with 34,000 fatalities in the U. S. every year. Texting while driving and hand holding a G.P.S. device increases accident risk exponentially.

Have you looked recently at your driver's license expiration date? I did and so did my wife. Surprise, surprise, both had expired. If the expiration date exceeds one year, you will be required to take all driving tests to renew your license.

By the way, do not leave the key in your car's ignition, while buying gas or while you are in a do-it-yourself car wash. There are at least two reasons. One it is easier to lock yourself out. The other is if your car doors are unlocked and you are distracted, it allows for a quick act of stealing your keys.

DO NOT CALL REGISTRY

From the website of the Federal Trade Commission -

Here's what you need to know about the National Do Not Call Registry program: FCC regulations prohibit telemarketers from using automated dialers to call cell phone numbers. Automated dialers are standard in the industry, so most telemarketers are barred from calling consumers on their cell phones without their consent. The federal government does not maintain a national cell phone registry. Personal cell phone users have always been able to add their numbers to the National Do Not Call Registry — the same Registry consumers use to register their land lines either online at <u>www.donotcall.gov</u> or by calling toll-free 1-888-382-1222 from the telephone number they wish to register. Registrations become effective within 31 days of signing up and are active for five years. There is no cutoff date or deadline for registrations. Businessto-business calls are not covered under the Registry.

- 50 million children a day access the Internet
- 49% of children did not report solicitations to anyone
- 90% of children the JeffCo D.A.'s office has talked with give out too much personal information online

Safety Tips from the Cheezo Unit from the JeffCo D.A.'s office:

- Place the computer in a visible area, not in child's bedroom.
- Use gender-neutral screen names.
- Talk to children about Internet safety and participate with them online.
- Children should not believe anything said to them over the Net from an unknown source.
- Tell children they do not have to respond to messages sent to them, whether by email or instant message.
- Children should never give out personal information, screen names, passwords or credit card information online.
- Use a good virus detection program.
- Do not rely on filtering software to supervise your children's computer usage.
- Know who your children are communicating with online. Get to know their online friends just as you would their other friends.
- Promote an environment where your children can talk openly with you.
